
To enter your position on a bill

"Your position is entered directly on the Bill record and cannot be altered or removed by anyone but you. It is visible to anyone, but most importantly to every legislator and the governor when they are voting on any bill. This is the most powerful tool available to any citizen to let your government know how you feel about an issue."


1) Go to www.AZLEG.gov



- 2) Click on 'Legislative Information' (Green box)
- 3) Then click on the 'Request to Speak' (Blue box)




4) Log into your account (Red Box)



- 5) Enter your username and password (Orange)
- 6) Press Sign On (Green)



7) Click on 'My Bill Position' (Yellow box)

- 8) Type in the Bill number in Blue box (Just the numbers, no letters)
- 9) Click after the number with your left mouse key and you will see the Green Box appear with the name of the bill.
- 10) Click on the green box to select that Bill
- 11) The full name of the bill will replace the number you put in. (Orange box)
 12) Click For or Neutral or Against (Red box)
 13) Click 'Add' (Green Box)
- 14) Your position is now recorded (Green Box)15) You have made your voice known.
