Request To Speak (RTS)

This process can only be used once a bill is included on the agenda for a standing committee of the Legislature.


RTS allows you to post a position on any bill before a committee and to provide comments (250 characters) directly to the committee members hearing that bill.

It also allows you to indicate if you will be present at the committee hearing and desire to speak to the committee directly about the bill.


1) Go to www.AZLEG.gov



- 2) Click on 'Legislative Information' (Green box)
- 3) Then click on the 'Request to Speak' (Blue box)




4) Log into your account (Red Box)




- 5) Enter your username and password (Orange)

Don't worry, you don't have to speak in front of anyone







8) Click on 'New Request' (Red box)

- 14) Click: Yes OR No OR If Necessary (Green)

- 16) Press Submit (Red)
